We hope this letter finds you well. As we approach the culmination of your child's GCSE journey, we would like to provide you with important details regarding the upcoming **GCSE Results Day on Thursday, 20th August 2026**

Results Collection:

Pupils can collect their GCSE results between **10:00 AM and 12:00 PM**. To ensure a smooth process, students **must bring a valid photo ID with them** (*School student Card, Passport, Provisional Driving license*).

Alternative Arrangements:

If your child is unable to collect their results in person, the following options are available:

1. Results by Post or Email:

A signed letter from both the student and a parent/guardian is required. This letter can be submitted to Student Reception by 1st August or emailed to Mrs Lane at exams@orchard-tmet.uk.

2. Collection by a Parent/Guardian:

A parent/guardian may collect the results on the student's behalf. A signed letter from both the student and a parent/guardian is required. This letter can be submitted to Student Reception by 1st August or emailed to Mrs Lane at exams@orchard-tmet.uk. The person collecting the results must bring valid photo ID matching the information sent in the letter.

Support and Guidance:

We understand that Results Day can be a stressful time. To support our students:

- Careers advisors will be available to offer guidance, especially for those who may not have achieved the grades required for their chosen courses.
- A quiet room will be available for students who prefer to open their results in a calm, private space.

Access to Scripts:

There may be occasions when we wish to access your child's exam scripts—either to view/see them before requesting a review of your paper or to use them for educational purposes. Your consent is essential for this and is invaluable in helping us improve our teaching methods. Pupils will be able to sign the consent form and hand it in on Results Day.
